# About Our Virtual Academy

Math Magnet School

Project Motivational Math Inc. (PMM) Virtual Academy & Math Magnet School opens in August 2008. Students in grades 7-12 will get their lessons and complete assignments on-line and by mail or they will have the option of attending school at our on-site location in Fairfield, Alabama. Those who choose to attend the Virtual

School will communicate with their teachers and each other through the PMM website, email, telephone and/or facsimile.

The most important feature of this virtual school is the motivation factor. PMM is dedicated to keeping students motivated through-out the school year with opportunities to participate in on-line mental math competitions, Bible Bowl tournaments, Math & Science challenges, and Community Service projects. Students will be eligible for prizes, honors & awards as well as chances to be featured in the school's newsletter and on the website monthly.

## OPTION A: Home School Setting

Students are taught in a home school environment taking most of their courses on-site at the Learning Center located in Fairfield, Alabama. No more than 2 classes are taught on-line. Tutoring in math and reading is available.

### OPTION B: Virtual Academy

Students are taught in an web environment taking all of their courses via internet and sending in their submissions by mail. The classroom is the Project Motivational Math website. Students receive instruction, tutoring and classroom interaction via multimedia, podcasts and blogging.

One of the major assets to the PMM Virtual Program is that it is a math magnet school specifically focusing on building mathematical excellence. Students will have an opportunity to use world applications in mathematics. Career options are explored.

PMM is a strong curriculum enhancement tool that serves to reinforce and build upon methods and techniques previously learned in a traditional classroom setting while taking the student to the next level of creative problem solving and developing critical thinking skills. PMM also offers courses in Science, Bible, English, Literature, History, Foreign Language, Technology and Electives.

PMM ran a pilot program for the 2007-2008 school year at the Learning Center located in Fairfield, Alabama. There were eleven students in grades 9-12. Students took four classes in-house, two classes on-line and one class via submissions. Five seniors are graduating in June 2008.

Students receive their diplomas from Griggs International Academy located in Maryland. 20 hours of Community Service must also be completed before graduation. Griggs Academy is S.A.C.S. accredited.
